

### Science

Over the course of this first half term, Comet Class will be investigating electricity and electrical circuits. There will be a real focus on using the correct scientific terminology and learning about the correct symbols when drawing diagrams when investigating their own electrical circuits.

### PE

This half term we will be practising our striking and fielding skills through rounders. Children will learn the rules and tactics of the game as well as improve their batting and catching abilities.

### French:

We will be revising our greetings in formal and informal situations. We will be exploring basic nouns and revising numbers 1- 10 and beyond through interactive stories, role-play, and games.

### Art

This half term we are studying the work of street/pop artists and activists Banksy and Keith Haring. We will explore and compare their styles before turning our hands to our own work influenced by these artists.

## Comet Class Autumn 1

### Power Maths

This year, Comet Class will begin the year with a focus on number, place value and the four operations. By the end of the half term year three will be focusing on Money whereas year 6 will have begun work on ratio.

This half term the children will enjoy Outdoor Learning with Mrs Wands on a Wednesday afternoon.

### Geography

This half term, we will be using our Geography time to answer the question: How is Climate Change affecting the world? This will include learning about communities in The Gambia and in Australia to compare and contrast the way climate change is impacting different regions of the world in different ways. We will also learn about how we can play our part in the fight against climate change and learn about the climate activist, Greta Thunberg.

### Computing

During this half term, the children will be working towards the goal of creating a film which could be used as a promotional video for the school. The children will use a range of software on the iPads and the laptops to create a video which they will plan, edit and produce themselves.

### PSHE: Being me in my world.

The children will learn to set goals. They will also learn that all children have universal rights but that not all children in the world are given them. The pupils will learn how their actions can affect people locally and globally. We will also discuss what democracy means.

### Talk for Writing

The children will learn about and write their own: Finding tales, where the main character learns a lesson about themselves. Later on in the half term, they will write a persuasive letter and a poem based on The Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe.
